2. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE ENROLLED IN 4-H BY NOVEMBER 21, 2014**
3. **ALL “Watch Me Grow” entries MUST be checked in on date posted above. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. All exhibitors must be 5 to 7 years old as of September 1, 2014.
5. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) item in a class; Exhibitor may enter a TOTAL of three (3) projects. **(A plant would count as one project in the total of three (3)).**
6. **NO FOOD ITEMS PERMITTED. (Jams, jellies, relishes, etc. permitted)**
7. Entry must have been completed by the exhibitor between March 2014 and February 2015. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were student produced during this time period.
8. Articles must be cleaned, pressed and displayed on appropriate hardware.
9. Early pick-up of exhibit will not be allowed. All exhibits remain on display for the entire Fair.
10. Exhibits not picked up on the day and time listed above will be forfeited and become the property of the SEYF.
11. The Fair does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen articles. Supervision of exhibits will be provided during hours the exhibits are open to the public.
