- 1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
- 2. All dogs must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents). No dogs may be leased or loaned to the exhibitor.
- 3. Any originally registered dog unable to be shown for any reason, can not be replaced by any other dog.
- 4. Any handler who has never shown in this show must start in the Sub-Novice class.
- 5. Any dog and handler team having won 1<sup>st</sup> place in his class must advance to next class and may not return to a previous class.
- Any person who has shown the same dog for 2 years in Sub-Novice class and placed 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> may enter the Major Novice class if they choose.
- 7. No person may show two (2) dogs in the same class, nor the same dog in two (2) classes.
- 8. Dogs must be well groomed, washed and brushed with all mats removed from the coat, ears clean and nails trimmed.
- A dog with a leg toward any obedience title may enter THE ADVANCED CLASS only. A DOG WITH A CD TITLE IS INELIGIBLE.
- 10. A female dog in season will not be permitted to enter.
- 11. Any exhibitor with an uncontrollable dog will be asked to immediately remove that dog from the grounds.
- 12. No dog shall be individually hands-on trained by a professional dog trainer.
- 13. The Show Coordinator's determination as to dogs referred to in #7, #8, #9 and #10 shall be conclusive.
- 14. Exhibitor may submit one (1) record book for both Agility and Obedience, provided dog(s) are entered in both events. It will be judged for one (1) show only. You must designate which show when checking in.
- 15. See general rules for dress code requirements.

#### **SHOW DAY**

- 16. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. A six (6) foot leash with a choke-chain or nylon training collar is recommended. No pinch collars, lead collars, or harness will be accepted.
- 17. Exhibitors must register at the check-in table on the date and time shown above.
- 18. For safety reasons, no dogs are allowed in the barn, unless waiting in the designated area for the dog show. <u>Do not take dogs in any other area of the barn.</u> Anyone found violating this rule will be disqualified from the show.
- 19. Each exhibitor will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
- 20. All dogs must be off fair grounds within on half (1/2) hour after the Dog Show. Exception: If exhibitors are in the following show, their dogs must be secured in crates or under your direct supervision. No dogs may be left in stalls. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
- 21. Only dogs that are in the dog show will be allowed on the premises. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.

### **CLASSES**

- 22. **SUB-NOVICE** / This class **WILL** be divided into age groups. (Junior 8-10) (Intermediate 11-13) (Senior 14-18) All exercises will be done on leash: heel, figure eight, stand for exam, recall, one(1) minute sit, three(3) minute down
- 23. **MAJOR NOVICE** / This class **WILL NOT** be divided by age.

  You must have placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in Sub-Novice with this dog to enter this class. Exercises will be the same as Sub-Novice, except that the following will be off leash: stand for exam--- recall--- one(1) minute sit--- three(3) minute down.

24. **ADVANCED** / For a dog that has a LEG toward a title in any venue.

This class will not be divided by age. Exercise will be as follows: Healing on leash. The following will be off leash: Stand for exam, Heel Free, Recall, Long sit (1 minute), Long down (3 minutes). This class will be judged more strictly than Major Class.

### **AWARDS**

- 23. The Show Coordinator reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition.
- 24. Before PREMIUMS are paid, an ORIGINAL THANK YOU letter must be received in the fair office with a stamped addressed envelope to your sponsor. (1st & 2nd Place winners in Sub Novice, Jr. Int. Sr.; 1st & 2nd Place in Major Novice; and 1st & 2nd Place in Advanced.) will receive premiums.

Sub Novice – 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> places in Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions

Major Novice – 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> places

Advanced – 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place

Record Books –  $1^{st}$  through 3rd places in Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions. (Plagues awarded for  $1^{st}$  Place, Rosettes awarded for  $2^{nd}$  &  $3^{rd}$  Place.)
