- **AWARDS:** Immediately following show

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Scrapie tag or registration papers required for animal identification. See Animal Inspection Rules 5C-4.005 goats or sheep. **ALL ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON SHOW DAY.**
3. **NO OPEN WOUNDS AT INITIAL OR FINAL WEIGH-IN. No fresh cut horns or castration wounds. Wounds MUST be completely healed.**
4. Meat Doe Goats, Market Wethers and Dairy Goats are in two separate shows and shall not compete against one another, nor may a goat be shown in both shows. **Pygmy goats do not have a separate class. They will compete against meat classes and judged to meat standards.**
5. **No exhibitor may enter more than one animal per class.** (i.e. 1 for market wether, 1 for junior meat doe, 1 for senior meat doe, 1 for junior dairy, 1 for senior dairy). **Exhibitor must show his or her own animal.**
6. Horned **Meat DOE** goats are allowed provided that no goat is unruly or abusive.
7. **NO HORNS ALLOWED ON MARKET WETHERS.**
8. No Bucks allowed to be shown.
9. Kids must be born before November 1, 2017 in order to be entered and shown.
10. **Market Goats can be ordered the night of the MANDATORY MEETING. TOTAL Purchase price for Market Goats will be \$230.00. If you purchase your goat from the SEYF, FULL payment will be accepted at the Mandatory Meeting or FULL PAYMENT can be made in the SEYF office by September 29, 2017. (NO partial payments will be accepted)**
11. **MARKET WETHERS EXHIBITORS are required to write Buyer Letters & Thank you letters. See General Rules #59 through #69.**

## **SHOW DAY**

12. Record books are due in the SEYF office during the week of February 5-9<sup>th</sup>, 2018. COMPLETED BOOKS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL 6:00PM ON THE FINAL DAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2018. (General rule #43)
13. **\*ALL MARKET WETHERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A MARKET ANIMAL BOOK to be turned in the week of February 5-9<sup>th</sup>, with the exception of the Financial Summary page which will be turned in on show day.**
14. **\*BREEDING MEAT DOES ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN ANIMAL BOOK. (See general rule #43)**
15. Failure to have an animal under control will result in disqualification. Prong or spike collars are not allowed. Exhibitor will be disqualified if used and will not be allowed in the ring.
16. Animal should be clean and have neatly trimmed hooves.
17. **ALL MARKET WETHERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CLIPPED ABOVE KNEES TO 3/8 INCHES.**
18. Showmanship is selected out of all classes throughout the day and brought back in to compete.

## **CLASSES**

19. The Show Coordinators reserve the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the overall show.
20. Market Classes will be determined after Final Weigh-In.

**\*\*Some classes will be divided into small groups according to entries. The top 5 of these groups will be brought back to show for the Class placings.**

<b>(ALL market wethers regardless of breed)</b>
