PURPOSE

To assist a participant, or participants, of the Southeastern Youth Fair to attend the College, University or Technical school of their choice.

- 2. Applicants must be high school seniors in Marion County and must have participated in the Southeastern Youth Fair for a minimum of three (3) years and be a participant in the current Youth Fair.
- 3. Completed applications must be received in the Fair office by January 12, 2018.

JUDGING CRITERIA & SELECTION

- 4. Application completeness, level of participation in the Southeastern Youth Fair, and college/vocational plans are the primary considerations.
- 5. Interviews will be held. Applicants will be notified of date and time.

AWARD

- 6. This scholarship is for tuition, books and instructional materials used during college or vocational-technical school of the recipient's choice.
- 7. Documentation such as class schedules or receipt of book purchases must be submitted to the Fair office before funds are dispersed.
