AGILITY AND RALLY CLASSES ARE AVAILABLE TO 4-H and FFA EXHIBITORS.
Rally classes are being offered at the SELP (back arena) @ 6:30pm beginning November 16th.

A CURRENT SIGNED VETERINARIAN SLIP WITH CURRENT VACCINATIONS COVERING EXPIRATION DATES MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE RECORD BOOK

Distemper-----hepatitis-----lepto-pl-----parvo-----rabies

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. All dogs must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents). No dogs may be leased or loaned to the exhibitor.
3. No person may show two (2) dogs in the same class, or the same dog in two (2) classes.
4. No dog shall be shown by more than one exhibitor (regardless of class entered).
5. A female dog in season will not be permitted to enter.
6. Any exhibitor with an uncontrollable dog will be asked to immediately remove that dog from the grounds.
7. No dog shall be individually hands-on trained by a professional trainer.
8. The show Coordinator's determination as to dogs referred to in #5, #6, and #7 shall be conclusive.
9. Exhibitor may submit one (1) record book for Rally/Agility, and Obedience provided dog(s) are entered in both events. It will be judged for one (1) show only. You must designate which show when checking in.

10. See general rules for dress code requirements.

SHOW DAY

11. Dogs must be clean and well groomed, ears clean and nails trimmed.
12. **Collars:** A six (6) foot leash with a choke-chain or nylon training collar is recommended.
13. Dogs must be on a leash at all times until they enter the rally ring.
14. No food, treats, or toys will be allowed within 10 feet of the entrance to the ring.
15. Each exhibitor will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
16. All dogs must be off fair grounds within one half hour (1/2 hour) after the Dog show.
exception: If exhibitors are in the following show, their dogs must be secured in crates or under your direct supervision. No dogs may be left in stalls. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
17. Only dogs that are in the dog show will be allowed on the premises. Failure to comply may Result in disqualification from the show.

CLASSES: **Any dog that has placed 1st in any 4-H or previous SEYF dog show MUST move up to the next level**

18. Elementary: (On leash) – This class may be divided into age groups

Elementary is for the first year handlers with first year dogs. If the dog and/or handler has earned any titles in Rally or Obedience from any venue (i.e. AKC, UKC, etc.) or has shown in any 4-H dog rally or obedience show prior to entry, they are not eligible to compete in Elementary. Elementary Rally will have between 10-15 stations (Start and Finish not included.)

19. **Novice: (On leash) – This class may be divided into age groups**

Novice is for dogs and/or handlers with no titles in Rally or Obedience from any recognized outside venue (i.e., AKC, UKC, etc.). Novice Rally will have between 10-15 stations (Start and Finish not included.)

20. **Advanced: (Off leash) – Advanced class may or may not be divided into age groups**

Advanced is for dogs and/or handlers who are experienced or have earned a title in Rally or Obedience in any recognized outside venue. Advanced Rally will have between 12 and 17 stations (Start and Finish not included), plus one required jump per class (either high jump, bar jump, or broad jump). Broad jump will be set up at twice the height of the regular jump height.

Handlers in their first year showing in the SEYF dog Rally or Obedience show may choose to enter any class they feel comfortable entering. Any handlers or dogs in their second year or greater must enter Novice or Advanced. Any handlers or dogs with Rally or Obedience titles from any recognized outside venue must enter Advanced.

JUMP HEIGHTS FOR ADVANCED CLASS

21. The dog's jump height shall be given on the entry form. If you have not had your dog Measured, please arrive 15 minutes early the day of show. Entries will be arranged according to the jump height of the dogs, from either high to low or low to high.

<u>Height of the dog at withers</u>	<u>Height to be jumped</u>
Dogs measuring 10" and under	4"
Dogs measuring 11" – 14"	8"
Dogs measuring 15" – 18"	12"
Dogs measuring 19" and over	16"

GENERAL SCORING

22. Judging will be based on times and faults. Times will be used to break ties for placements.
23. Rally Deductions will be made for any of the following: tight leash, dogs interfering with Handler, poor sits, slow, delay, or resistance to respond, touching or knocking over a jump or Cone or touching handler, lack of control, loud command or intimidating signal, excessive barking, incorrectly performed station, lack of teamwork, lack of briskness, handler error.
24. Fouling the ring will be assessed a 50 point penalty.
25. Handlers in all classes may not touch the dog at any time while on the courses.
26. No "physical" handling of the dog will be permitted.
27. All penalties and comments made by the judge or scribe are final.

AWARDS

28. The Show Coordinator reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition.
29. 1st through 4th place for all classes, separated by age divisions when deemed appropriate
30. Record Books – 1st through 4th places
31. Skill-a-thon – 1st through 3rd places, Junior, Intermediate, & Senior Divisions (combined with Dog Obedience and Agility)
32. **Combined HIGH POINT DOG AWARD to receive a BELT BUCKLE**
*Combined scores in: Obedience; Agility; Rally; Skill-a-thon; one-record book.
Exhibitor must participate in each one of these events/contests AND are required to SHOW THE SAME DOG with the SAME HANDLER.
