1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Scrapie tag or registration papers required for animal identification. See Animal Inspection Rules 5C-4.055 goats or sheep. **ALL ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON SHOW DAY.**
3. **NO OPEN WOUNDS AT INITIAL OR FINAL WEIGH-IN. No fresh cut horns or castration wounds. Wounds MUST be completely healed.**
4. **Market Wethers will only be shown in the Market class. Wethers ONLY in Market class, NO bucks, NO does. Market wethers must be born prior to September 1st 2018. PYGMY Goats DO NOT have a separate class. They must meet 45 lb. minimum weight requirement.**
5. **No exhibitor may enter more than one animal per class.**
6. **NO HORNS ALLOWED ON MARKET WETHERS.**
7. **Market Goats can be ordered the night of the MANDATORY MEETING. TOTAL purchase price for Market Goats will be \$230.00. If you purchase your goat from the SEYF, FULL payment will be accepted at the Mandatory Meeting or FULL PAYMENT can be made in the SEYF office by September 21, 2018.**
8. **Market Wether Exhibitors are required to write Buyer Letters & Thank you letters. See General Rules #59-69.**
9. Record books are due in the SEYF office during the week of February 4-8th, 2019. COMPLETED BOOKS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL 6:00pm ON THE FINAL DAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2019. (General rule #43)

SHOW DAY

10. *ALL MARKET WETHERS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE A MARKET ANIMAL BOOK to be turned in the week of February 4-8th, with the EXCEPTION of the Financial Summary page which will be turned in on show day.
11. Failure to have an animal under control will result in disqualification. Prong or spike collars are not allowed. Exhibitor will be disqualified if used and will not be allowed in the ring.
12. Animal should be clean and have neatly trimmed hooves.
13. All Market Wethers should be clipped above knees to 3/8 inches.

CLASSES

14. The Show Coordinators reserve the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the overall show.
15. Market Classes will be determined after Final Weigh-In.

**Some classes will be divided into small groups according to entries. The top three (3) of these groups will be brought back to show for the Class placing.
