- **MOCK GOAT SHOW:** Saturday, January 5, 2019 @ 9:00am – SELP

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Scrapie tag or registration papers required for animal identification. See Animal Inspection Rules 5C-4.005 goats or sheep. **ALL ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON SHOW DAY.**
No fresh cut horns. Wounds MUST be completely healed.
3. Meat Doe Goats, Market Wethers and Dairy Goats are in two separate shows and shall not compete against one another, nor may a goat be shown in both shows. **Pygmy goats do not have a separate class. They will compete against meat classes and judged to meat standards.**
4. **No exhibitor may enter more than one animal per class.** (i.e 1 for junior meat doe, 1 for senior meat doe).
Exhibitor must show his or her own animal.
5. Horned **Meat DOE** goats are allowed provided that no goat is unruly or abusive.
6. Kids must be born before November 1, 2018 in order to be entered and shown.

SHOW DAY

7. Record books are due in the SEYF office during the week of February 4-8th, 2019. COMPLETED BOOKS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNTIL 6:00PM ON THE FINAL DAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2019. (General rule #43)
8. ***BREEDING MEAT DOES ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN ANIMAL BOOK. (See general rule #43)**
9. Failure to have an animal under control will result in disqualification. Prong or spike collars are not allowed. Exhibitor will be disqualified if used and will not be allowed in the ring.
10. Animal should be clean and have neatly trimmed hooves.
11. Showmanship is selected out of all classes throughout the day and brought back in to compete.

CLASSES

12. The Show Coordinators reserve the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the overall show.

****Some classes will be divided into small groups according to entries. The top three (3) of these groups will be brought back to show for the Class placings.**
