Vet slip required with ENTRY FORM: Distemper (DHPP) = Parvo - Bordetella, Rabies

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. All dogs must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents). No dogs may be leased or loaned to the exhibitor.
3. Any originally registered dog cannot be replaced by another dog for any reason. Any questions, contact the dog committee.
4. Dog must be 6 months of age before or on September 1, 2018 to participate.
5. Basic class is only for first year dog and handler only!!
6. Sub-novice class is for exhibitors that have previously shown a dog in the SEYF or have shown for two (2) years. If this applies to you, you must move up to the next class.
7. Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in sub-novice class or has shown for two (2) years Prior in sub- novice class.
8. Advanced class is for exhibitors who placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the novice class; or if dog has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue.
9. Exhibitors may not show 2 dogs in the same class nor the same dog in 2 classes. Only 3 dogs allowed per exhibitor.
10. Prior to the show exhibitors must have their dog well groomed, washed, ears clean, brushed and nails trimmed.
11. No female dogs in season permitted.
12. A dog with a leg toward any obedience title may enter THE ADVANCED CLASS only. **A DOG WITH A CD TITLE IS INELIGIBLE.**
13. Any exhibitor with an uncontrollable dog will be asked to immediately remove that dog from the grounds.
14. No dog shall be individually hands-on trained by a professional dog trainer or parent. All exhibitors must attend training and train their dog prior to show for at least 3 months.
15. ONLY ONE RECORD BOOK per exhibitor may be submitted regardless of how many dog shows you are entered in. (i.e. Obedience, Agility, Rally) It will be designated DOG RECORD BOOK.
16. NO dogs will be allowed on fair property prior to the day of show. You will be dismissed from the show if this rule is not obeyed.
17. See general rules for dress code requirements.
18. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. A six (6) foot leash with a choke-chain, nylon training collar, or martingale are required. NO pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted. No flex leashes will be accepted.

SHOW DAY

19. Exhibitors must register at the check-in table on the date and time shown above. Exhibitors must have the proper equipment for their dog and follow dress code requirements. Failure to do so will be cause for dismissal from the show.
20. For safety reasons, no dogs are allowed in the barn. Anyone found violating this rule will be disqualified from the show.
21. Each exhibitor will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
22. All dogs must be off fair grounds within one half (1/2) hour after the Dog Show. Exception: If exhibitors are in the following show, their dogs must be properly crated under your direct supervision. No stalls may be used for dogs and dogs are not to be left in cars. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
23. Only dogs that are in the dog show will be allowed on the premises. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
24. All judge’s decisions are final.
25. Show coordinator reserves the right to make changes as necessary for the success and the safety of the dogs and exhibitors.
26. Failure to follow any of the above rules will result in dismissal from the show.
27. The Show Committee shall reserve the right to refuse entry or show participation to any aggressive people or animals.
28. NO Food treats or toys will be allowed inside dog show arena.

2019 DOG OBEDIENCE SHOW

CLASSES: Any dog who has placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd; or have shown in a class for previous two (2) years in the SEYF Dog show MUST move up to the next level.

29. **BASIC- Basic is for first year handlers with first year dogs. This class WILL be divided into age groups.** This class will be divided into age groups of exhibitors. (Junior 8-10) (Intermediate 11-13) (Senior 14-18) All exercises will be done on leash; heel, figure eight, sit for exam, recall, sit-stay for one minute.
30. **SUB NOVICE – This class WILL NOT be divided by age groups.**
Sub-novice class is for exhibitors that have previously shown a dog in the SEYF or have shown for two (2) years. All exercises will be done on leash; heel, figure eight, stand for exam, recall, sit-stay for one (1) minute and down stay for three (3) minutes.
31. **NOVICE - This class WILL NOT be divided by age group.**
Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in sub-novice class or has shown for two (2) years prior in sub-novice class. Some exercises will be on leash; heel and figure eight. OFF leash; stand for exam, recall, sit-stay one (1) minute, down stay three (3) minutes.
32. **ADVANCED – This class WILL NOT be divided by age group.**
Advanced class is for exhibitors who placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the novice class; or if dog has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue. Some exercises will be **ON leash**; heel, figure eight; **OFF leash**; heel free, stand for exam, recall, sit-stay, (walking around ring), down stay three (3) minutes.

AWARDS

The Show Coordinator reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition.

Basic Class – 1st through 3rd places, Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions

Sub Novice – 1st through 3rd places

Novice – 1st through 3rd places

Advanced – 1st through 3rd place

Record Book (from all dog shows collectively)–1st through 3rd places in Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions.

Plaques award for 1st place; Rosettes awarded for 2nd & 3rd Place

Skill-a-thon – 1st through 3rd places, Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions (combined with Dog Agility & Rally)

HIGH POINT DOG AWARD – Belt Buckle

All exhibitors will receive a participation ribbon

Combined HIGH POINT DOG AWARD to receive a BELT BUCKLE

***Combined scores in: Obedience; Agility; Rally; Skill-a-thon; one-record book.**

Exhibitor must participate in each one of these events/contests AND are required to SHOW THE SAME DOG with the SAME HANDLER.
