Vet Slip required with ENTRY FORM: Distemper (DHPP) – Parvo – Bordetella, Rabies

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. All dogs must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents). No dogs may be leased or loaned to the exhibitor.
3. Any originally registered dog cannot be replaced by another dog for any reason. Any questions, contact the dog committee.
4. Dogs must be 15 months of age before or on September 1, 2018 to participate.
5. Basic class is only for first year dog and handler only!!
6. Sub-novice class is for exhibitors that have previously shown a dog in the SEYF or have shown for two (2) years. If this applies to you, you must move up to the next class.
7. Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in sub-novice class or has shown for two (2) years prior in sub-novice class.
8. Advanced class is for exhibitors who place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the novice class; or if dog has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue.
9. Exhibitors may not show 2 dogs in the same class nor the same dog in 2 classes. Only 3 dogs allowed per exhibitor.
10. Prior to the show, exhibitors must have their dog well groomed, washed, ears, clean, brushed and nails trimmed.
11. No female dogs in season permitted.
12. Any exhibitor with an uncontrollable dog will be asked to immediately remove that dog from the grounds.
13. No dog shall be individually hands-on trained by a professional dog trainer or parent. All exhibitors must attend training and train their dog prior to show for at least 3 months.
14. ONLY ONE RECORD BOOK per exhibitor may be submitted regardless of how many dog shows you are entered in. (i.e. Obedience, Agility, Rally) It will be designated DOG RECORD BOOK.
15. NO dogs will be allowed on fair property prior to the day of show. You will be dismissed from the show if this rule is not obeyed.
16. **HEIGHT CARDS MUST ACCOMPANY YOUR ENTRY FORM.** (jump height must be checked and verified by a committee member prior to show)
17. **See general rules for dress code requirements.**
18. **Collars: Agility** – Flat Buckle only; No tags or attachments are allowed. Six (6) foot leash. NO pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted. No flex leashes will be accepted.
19. Dogs must be on a leash at all times until they enter the agility ring.

SHOW DAY

20. All dogs must be off of fair grounds within one half hour (1/2 hour) after the Dog Show. Exception: If exhibitors are in the following show, their dogs must be properly crated under your direct supervision. No stalls may be used for dogs and dogs are not to be left in cars. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
- 21 **No food, treats, or toys will be allowed inside dog show arena.**
22. No contact familiarization before each class.
23. Each exhibitor will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.

24. **Only dogs that are in the dog show will be allowed on the premises. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.**
25. All judge's decisions are final.
26. Show coordinator reserve the right to make changes as necessary for the success and the safety of the Dogs and exhibitors.
27. **Failure to follow any of the rules will result in dismissal from the show.**

CLASSES: Any dog who has placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd; or have shown in a class for two (2) previous years in the SEYF dog show MUST move up to the next level.

28. **BASIC: (On leash) – This class will be divided into age groups.**

This is for the first year handlers with first year dogs **ONLY**.

Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Basic is a simple course using the following: A-frame, dog walk, tunnel, table for each dog's height, sit or down (at judge's discretion) for 5 cumulative seconds and approximately 6 jumps.

29. **Sub-Novice: (On leash) – This class will not be divided into age groups.**

Sub-Novice class is for exhibitors that have previously shown a dog in the SEYF or have shown for two (2) Years. Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Sub-Novice uses the following course: A-frame, dog walk, tunnel, table for each dog's height, sit or down (at judge's discretion) for 5 cumulative seconds, approximately 6 jumps.

30. **Novice: (Off Leash) – This class will not be divided into age groups**

Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in sub-novice class or has shown for two (2) years prior in sub-novice class.

Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Novice will have the same obstacles as in the Sub-Novice Class but in addition there will be the following: tire and set of 6 weave poles.

31. **Advanced: (Off leash) - This class will not be divided into age group.**

Advanced class is for exhibitors who place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the novice class; or if dog has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue. Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Advanced agility course will be more complex, using the same obstacles as the Novice Class, but in addition, there will be the following: 12 weave poles and teeter.

JUMP HEIGHTS FOR ALL CLASS

32. The dog's jump height shall be given on the entry form. (A JUMP HEIGHT CARD IS REQUIRED) Entries will be arranged according to the jump height of the dogs.

Height of the dog at withers

Dogs measuring 10" and under
Dogs measuring 11" – 14"
Dogs measuring 15" – 18"
Dogs measuring 19" – 22"
Dogs measuring 23" and over

Height to be jumped

8"
12"
16"
20"
24"

Broad jump is to be set up at twice the height the dog jumps.

Elementary class awards in Junior, Intermediate, & Senior Divisions: 1st through 3rd Place

Sub-Novice – 1st through 3rd Place

Novice - 1st through 3rd places

Advanced – 1st through 3rd places

Record Book (FROM ALL DOG SHOWS COLLECTIVELY) 1st through 3rd Place, Junior, Intermediate, Senior Divisions.

Skill-a-thon – 1st through 3rd Place, Jr., Intermediate, & Senior Divisions

High Point Dog Award – Belt Buckle

All exhibitors will receive a participation ribbon

Combined HIGH POINT DOG AWARD to receive a BELT BUCKLE

***Combined scores in: Obedience; Agility; Rally; Skill-a-thon; one-record book.**

Exhibitor must participate in each one of these event/contest AND are required to SHOW THE SAME DOG with the SAME HANDLER.
