Vet Slip required with ENTRY FORM: Distemper (DHPP) – Parvo – Bordetella - Rabies

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. All dogs must be owned by the exhibitor or their immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents). No dogs may be leased or loaned to the exhibitor.
3. Any originally registered dog cannot be replaced by another dog for any reason. Any questions, contact the dog committee.
4. Dog must be 6 months of age before or on September 1, 2019 to participate.
5. Basic class is only for first year dog and handler only!!
6. Sub -Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in Basic or has shown for two (2) years. If this applies to you, you must move up to the next class. If dog or handler has shown in an outside dog venue in any type (i.e. ACK, CPE, UKC, etc.) you **CANNOT** show in this class.
7. Advanced class is for exhibitors who placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in Novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the Novice class; or if dog or handler has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue (i.e. ACK, CPE, UKC, etc.)
8. Exhibitors may not show 2 dogs in the same class nor the same dog in 2 classes. Only 3 dogs allowed per exhibitor.
9. Prior to the show exhibitors must have their dog well groomed, washed, ears clean, brushed and nails trimmed.
10. No female dogs in season permitted.
11. A dog with a leg toward any Rally title may enter THE ADVANCED CLASS only. **A DOG WITH A RALLY TITLE IS INELIGIBLE.**
12. Any exhibitor with an uncontrollable dog will be asked to immediately remove that dog from the grounds.
13. No dog shall be individually hands-on trained by a professional dog trainer or parent. All exhibitors must attend training and train their dog prior to show for at least 3 months.
14. ONLY ONE RECORD BOOK per exhibitor may be submitted regardless of how many dog shows you are entered in. (i.e. Obedience, Agility, Rally) It will be designated DOG RECORD BOOK.
15. NO dogs will be allowed on fair property prior to the day of show. You will be dismissed from the show if this rule is not obeyed.
16. See general rules for dress code requirements.
17. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. A six (6) foot leash only with a choke-chain, nylon training collar, or martingale are required. NO pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted. No flex leashes will be accepted.

SHOW DAY

- 18.** Exhibitors must register at the check-in table on the date and time shown above. Exhibitors must have the proper equipment for their dog and follow dress code requirements. Failure to do so will be cause for dismissal from the show.
- 19.** No dogs injured, lame, sick or unhealthy are allowed to participate in events. All dogs must be physically able to perform all obstacles in class entered.
- 20.** Each exhibitor will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
- 21.** All dogs must be off fair grounds within one (1) hour after the Dog Show. Exception: If exhibitors are in the following show; their dogs must be properly crated under your direct supervision. No stalls may be used for dogs and dogs are not to be left in cars. No dogs are allowed in barn area or co-mingled with any other animals. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
- 22.** Only dogs that are in the dog show will be allowed on premises. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the show.
- 23.** All judge's decision are final. Judge's decisions will not be changed or overruled.
- 24.** Show coordinator and committee reserves the right to make changes as necessary for the success and the safety of the dogs and exhibitors.
- 25.** Failure to follow any of the rules will result in dismissal from the show.
- 26.** The Show Coordinator and/or Committee shall reserve the right to refuse entry or show participation to any aggressive people or animals.
- 27.** NO food, treats, toys, trainers or parents will be allowed inside dog show arena. No coaching day of show from outside the arena.
- 28.** Dog show rules are guided by ACK and Florida State Fair rules but modified by Dog Show Committee to ensure success for participants. This is not an AKC, CPE, UKC, etc. event.

CLASSES: Any dog that has placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd or have shown in any previous SEYF dog show for two (2) years MUST move up.

29. BASIC: (On leash) – This class will be divided into age groups

Basic is for first year handlers with first year dogs only. **If you compete in any outside venue, (i.e. AKC, CPE, UKC, etc.) you CANNOT enter this class.**

Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Basic Rally will have between 9-13 stations (Start and Finish not included.)

30. Sub -Novice: (On leash) – This class will not be divided into age groups

Sub -Novice class is for exhibitors that have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in Basic or has shown for two (2) years. **If you compete in any outside venue, (i.e. AKC, CPE, UKC, etc.) you CANNOT enter this class.**

Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Sub-Novice Rally will have between 10-17 stations (Start and Finish not included.)

31. Advanced: (Off leash) – Advanced class will not be divided into age groups

Advanced class is for exhibitors who placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in Novice or has shown for previous two (2) years in the novice class; or if dog or handler has any leg or has a title from an outside dog venue (i.e. AKC, CPE, UKC, etc.)

Dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Advanced Rally will have between 12 and 17 stations (Start and Finish not included.)

AWARDS

The Show Coordinator and/or Committee reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition

Basic class awards in Junior, Intermediate, & Senior Divisions: 1st through 3rd place.

Sub Novice and Advanced Class – awards 1st through 3rd places

Record Book (FROM ALL DOG SHOWS COLLECTIVELY) –Junior, Intermediate & Senior Divisions: 1st through 3rd places.

Skill-a-thon – Junior, Intermediate, & Senior Divisions: 1st through 3rd places.

HIGH POINT DOG AWARD – Belt Buckle

Combined HIGH POINT DOG AWARD to receive a BELT BUCKLE

Combined scores in: Obedience; Agility; Rally; Skill-a-thon; one-record book.

Exhibitor must participate in each one of these events/contests AND are required to SHOW THE SAME DOG with the SAME HANDLER.
