- Anticipating future involvement in 2023 SEYF market animal show – Steer, Lamb, Goat or Hog
- Recommendation by 4-H club leader or FFA Advisor

Recommended students will be contacted during the SEYF. The Spirit Award winner will be announced on Saturday, March 5, 2022 (Hog Sale day). Moneys will be awarded when student registers at the Mandatory SEYF Meeting in September 2022.
