- 1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
- 2. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were produced by the exhibitor between March 2024 and February 2025.
- 3. Early pick-up of exhibits is not allowed. It is understood that all exhibits will remain on display for the entire Fair.
- 4. Exhibits and awards not picked up on the designated day and time will be forfeited and be returned to the SEYF.
- 5. The Southeastern Youth Fair will assume no responsibility or liability for the damage or loss of articles exhibited. Supervision will be provided during Fair hours.

CLASSES

- 6. Based on the number of entries the Show Coordinator may create or combine classes.
- 7. Each class is divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.
- 8. <u>All items must fit in one of the classes listed.</u> No items will be allowed for display only.
- 9. Exhibitors may enter up to a <u>TOTAL</u> of <u>5 items</u>. ONE item per CLASS per EXHIBITOR.
- 10. Classes 1 items must be framed or on canvas with hardware attached.
- 11. Class 3 items must indicate the ratio of the scale.
- 12. Class 7 may not be needlework items. <u>***See Sewing/Needlework Rules</u>
- 13. <u>All legos must be tightly secured on to a strong base. (Cardboard, wood, plastic, Lego baseplate, etc) Failure to do so will result in disqualification. Only LEGO and Duplo blocks may be used. No Megablocks, Kinex, Tinkertoys, boxes, paper, etc.</u>
- 14. ALL items must have a hook on the back for hanging.
- 15. All projects must be completed and ready for display at drop-off time (no wet paint, no un-attached items).

CLASS 1 – ART *Must be Framed or on Canvas with hardware attached.* Painting Drawing

CLASS 2 – SCULPTURE Clay Metal Pre-Molded Items Mixed Media Ceramics

CLASS 3 – SCALE MODELS *Must indicate the Ratio of Scale.* From a Kit Built from Scratch

CLASS 4 - WOODWORKING Toys (not from a kit) Wood Burning Handmade Items

CLASS 5 – FURNITURE (MUST be Hand-Made, not store bought and decorated) General

CLASS 6 – HOME DECORATIONS *May not be needlework items.* General

CLASS 7 – HAND-MADE CRAFTS Scrapbooks/Collages Jewelry (on display)

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String Art Diamond Art (all Diamond Art must be framed.)
