1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were produced by the exhibitor between March 2023 and February 2023.
3. Early pick-up of exhibits is not allowed. It is understood that all exhibits will remain on display for the entire Fair.
4. Exhibits and awards not picked up on the designated day and time will be forfeited and be returned to the SEYF.
5. The Southeastern Youth Fair will assume no responsibility or liability for the damage or loss of articles exhibited. Supervision will be provided during Fair hours.

CLASSES

6. Each class is divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.
7. Exhibitors may enter in (2) two different classes PLUS Class I - "Theme" (3 total)
8. Photographs must be 8" X 10". Photos must be properly matted with mattes available for purchase from the SEYF office. These are the only accepted mattes and are \$5.00 each. No framed photos will be accepted.

Class 1 - Theme of the year

Sunsets 🌅

When shooting try not to have a lot of houses or neighborhoods in the photos. Over a field, city skyline, beach. If shooting with a phone, make sure the settings are set to the largest file size and app and or program used that exports in full resolution. No pixelation! Points will be deducted.

Class 2 - **Flowers** 🌸

This is a macro "close up" shot. Make sure your hands are steady and camera focused on your subject. If you're using a phone, make sure detail is there when zoomed in! No motion blur, no pixelation, or loss of detail. Make sure your macro shot is well lit.

Class 3 - **K9** 🐕

Could be action shot, jumping, running, etc
Sleeping, posed, one dog in image. These shots need to be done outdoors, no inside shots.

Class 4 - **Food** 🍷

Make it look appetizing. Order something to-go if you need to and bring it home and dress up a plate. If interior lighting is dim, orange, and low take your dish outside and dress up out there. No direct sunlight for these shots!

10. Premiums may be awarded after all sponsorship has been collected and all expenses have been paid on individual shows & events.
