PURPOSE

To assist a participant, or participants, of the Southeastern Youth Fair to attend the College, University or Technical school of their choice.

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this program.
2. Applicants must be high school seniors in a Marion County 4-H and FFA program. They must have participated in the Southeastern Youth Fair for at least three (3) years and be involved in the current Youth Fair.
3. Completed applications must be received in the Fair office by January 16, 2025.

JUDGING CRITERIA & SELECTION

4. The primary considerations are Application completeness, level of participation in the Southeastern Youth Fair, and College, University, or Technical school plans.
5. Interviews will be held. Applicants will be notified of the date and time. Official 4-H or FFA dress is required.

AWARD

6. This scholarship is for help associated with post-secondary expenses during College, University, or Technical school of the recipient's choice.
7. Documentation such as class schedules or receipt of book purchases must be submitted to the Fair office before funds are dispersed.
8. Scholarship Award will be forfeited if proper paperwork and receipts are not submitted to the Fair office PRIOR to the second calendar year following the award.
9. An original Thank you letter to your sponsor must be submitted to the SEYF office no later than the deadline stated in the SEYF general rules.
