This Scholarship will be awarded to an Exhibitor that is involved in promoting the SEYF and may or may not participate in the Market Animal Projects in the current year. Other scholarships may also be awarded at the discretion of the Executive Board of the SEYF.

PURPOSE

To assist a participant, or participants, of the Southeastern Youth Fair to attend the College, University or Technical school of their choice.

- 1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this program.
- 2. Applicants must be high school seniors in Marion County and must have participated in the Southeastern Youth Fair for a minimum of three (3) years and be a participant in the current Youth Fair.
- 3. Completed applications must be received in the Fair office by January 12, 2024.

JUDGING CRITERIA & SELECTION

- 4. Application completeness, level of participation in the Southeastern Youth Fair, and college/vocational plans are the primary considerations.
- 5. Applications without ALL signatures will not be scored.
- 6. Interviews will be held. Applicants will be notified of date and time.

AWARD

- 7. This scholarship is for tuition, books and instructional materials used during college or vocational-technical school of the recipient's choice.
- 8. Documentation such as class schedules or receipt of book purchases must be submitted to the Fair office before funds are dispersed.
- 9. Scholarship Award will be forfeited if proper paperwork and receipts are not submitted to the Fair office PRIOR to the upcoming Fair.
