

2023 SOUTHEASTERN YOUTH FAIR BREEDING LAMB/EWE SHOW RULES

1. The SEYF General Rules and Regulations apply to this show.
2. This will be a Breeding Lamb Show for ewes only.
3. The exhibitor or club/chapter must own the lamb. No leased animals will be allowed.
4. Lambs may be ewes that have previously been shown in the SEYF Market Lamb Show IF they are Senior Ewes.
5. Junior ewes qualify if they will be shown in the current SEYF Market Lamb Show, are lambs that have been purchased from a qualified breeder, or a homegrown lamb.
6. All breed lambs must be in the exhibitor's possession and under their care by October 1, 2022.
7. Lambs do not have to be purchased in Florida, nor do they require a breeder's affidavit.
8. If you are raising a ewe for the Market Lamb Show and will also be showing that ewe in the Breeding Lamb Show, you may enter an optional Animal Record Book for the Breeding Show in addition to the mandatory Market Animal Record Book. See Calendar of Events for dates of when Record books are due to be turned in to the SEYF office.
9. If your ewe is also showing in the Market Animal Show, you MUST ENTER THE LAMB in an online entry for BOTH the market show AND the breed show and enter "Yes" to the question if you are showing them in both shows.
10. BREEDING EWES (which are not also in the Market Show) REQUIRE A COMPLETED ANIMAL RECORD BOOK, however multiple animals can be included in the same single Record Book.
11. Each exhibitor will be allowed to show only one (1) lamb in the Market show.

SHEARING

12. Shearing of all show lambs will be available before the Fair at the Livestock Pavilion for a fee. Dates, times and fees will be posted on the website.

SHOW DAY

13. Record books are due February 13-17, 2023 in the SEYF Office. If you are raising a ewe for the Market Lamb Show and will also be showing that ewe in the Breeding Lamb Show, you may enter an optional Animal Record Book for the Breeding Show in addition to the mandatory Market Animal Record Book.
14. Each exhibitor will be allowed to show only one (1) lamb in each class (EX: only one Junior Blackface Ewe, one Senior Blackface Ewe, one AOB Junior Ewe, and one AOB Senior Ewe).
15. The Lamb Committee reserves the right to review any entries, and may excuse any lamb from the Show.
16. Exhibitor must wear the official dress of his/her organization. (see General Rules #24)
17. Lambs will be shown with or without a halter, at the judge's discretion.

CLASSES

15. Classes will be determined after final check-in.

AWARDS

16. The Show Coordinator reserves the right to withhold awards if there is not sufficient competition.
17. Premiums may be awarded after all sponsorship has been collected and all expenses have been paid.
