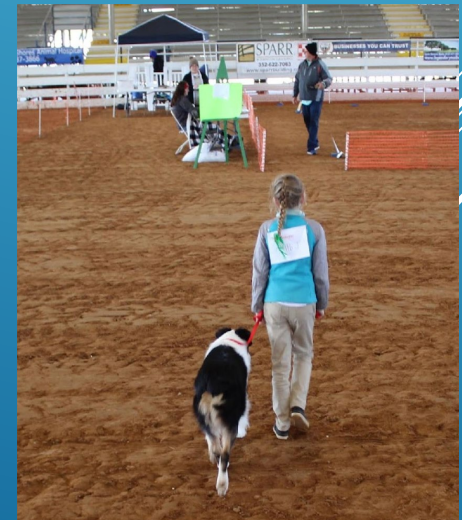

New last year: All exhibitors are required to show in Obedience or Rally in order to qualify to show that same dog in the Agility class.

TYPES OF COLLARS REQUIRED AT TRAINING AND DOG SHOW

OBEDIENCE & RALLY



- A six (6) foot leash only!
- **No** retractable/flex leashes will be accepted.
- Choke-chain, nylon training collar, Flat buckle collar or martingale are required.



- **NO** pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted.



TYPES OF COLLARS REQUIRED AT TRAINING AND DOG SHOW

AGILITY



- If in on-leash classes, a six (6) foot leash only!
- **NO** retractable/flex leashes will be allowed.
- Buckle Collar only; **No tags or attachments are allowed.**



- **NO** pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted.



PROOF OF UP-TO-DATE VACCINATIONS REQUIRED PRIOR TO TRAINING AND DOG SHOW!



- Please upload a legible copy of your dog's vaccination records with your entry or your entry will not be accepted.
- Please bring a copy of your dog's records with you to training.
- Training will NOT be provided if you do not have a copy of up-to-date vaccination records.
- Required: Bring an updated copy of your dog's vaccinations with you to check in at the show.
