

Beef Heifer Herdsman Guidelines

The Herdsman award is designed to encourage and acknowledge the great work ethic of any 4-H or FFA Exhibitor during the Beef Heifer show. Committee members will make all final decisions to determine the winners. The following guidelines will be considered when choosing the top three contestants.

- The name of the exhibitor and club/chapter must be clearly posted.
- The isle must be clear of all items and tack boxes.
- Exhibitors must care and feed their own animal.
- Stalls must be cleaned daily.
- Animals must be checked on periodically.
- Dressed in proper attire when showing animals and in barn.
- Exhibitor shall show respect, consideration, proper attitude and cooperation toward ALL animals, members, equipment, supplies and facilities as well as judges and spectators.
- Fill out and properly display stall cards.
- Ready to show and be on time for classes.
- Rules and regulations of the barn are followed.
- Has an attitude of good sportsmanship.
- Helpful to other exhibitors and committee members.

Awards will be acknowledged for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed 4-H or FFA exhibitors.
