5. This show will be scheduled in conjunction with the Meat, Dairy & Market Goat Shows.

This is an exhibit for 5 – 7 year old 4-H members.

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE ENROLLED IN 4-H BY November 17, 2023.
3. ALL “Watch Me Grow” entries MUST be checked in on date posted on SEYF Calendar of Events. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. All exhibitors must be 5 to 7 years old as of September 1, 2023.
5. Exhibitors may enter only one (1) item in a class; Exhibitor may enter a TOTAL of three (3) projects. (A plant would count as one project in the total of three (3)).
6. NO FOOD ITEMS PERMITTED. (Jams, jellies, relishes, etc. permitted)
7. Entry must have been completed by the exhibitor between March 2023 and February 2024. A teacher, leader, or parent is responsible for ensuring exhibits were student produced during this time period.
8. Articles must be cleaned, pressed and displayed on appropriate hardware.
9. Early pick-up of exhibit will not be allowed. All exhibits remain on display for the entire Fair.
10. Exhibits not picked up on the day and time listed on the Calendar of Events will be forfeited and become the property of the SEYF.
11. The Fair does not assume responsibility for lost or stolen articles. Supervision of exhibits will be provided during hours the exhibits are open to the public.
