

## **DOG SHOW REMINDERS**

- > Closed toed shoes are required for practicing.
- > Exhibitors are required to submit proof of vaccinations with entries.
- ➤ Exhibitors are responsible for knowing and following show rules. A few changes have been made this year.
- Exhibitors must have control of their dog(s) at all times.
- Dogs must be trained by the exhibitor, not by parents or other family members.
- > Aggressive dogs that cannot be controlled by the exhibitor will be asked to leave.
- > Exhibitors must clean up after their dog(s).
- > Proper collars are required and will be checked.
- > Please have a treat bag and treats with you at every practice.
- > Only dogs participating in the SEYF are allowed at practices.
- > Make sure your Record book is turned in correctly and you get your receipt.

## **SHOW DAY RULES**

- Exhibitors must abide by SEYF dress code. (Tennis shoes allowed.)
- > Required Exhibitors must bring updated vaccinated records with them to check-in.
- Required Exhibitors must bring a Sponsor Thank you letter with them to check-in.
- Only exhibitors and authorized personnel will be allowed in the arena during the show.
- > No dogs are permitted in the barn areas.
- > Dogs must be kenneled or supervised on a leash when not in the arena.
- > No dogs are allowed to practice on the property prior to the day of show. This will result in disqualification.
- Only dogs entered in the show will be permitted on show grounds.
- No outside training or coaching will be permitted while exhibitors are in the arena. This will result in disqualification.
- There will be NO day of show changes.
  - o If you are showing another animal during the dog show please let us know at check in.
- All judge's decisions are final.
- > The Dog Show Committee shall reserve the right to refuse show participation to anyone not following the rules and/or any aggressive people or animals.
