

## 2026 SOUTHEASTERN YOUTH FAIR DAIRY GOAT SHOW

1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Only females of the major dairy breeds are allowed. Does may be registered or grade. Grade animals must possess characteristics of their particular dairy breed.
3. Meat goats and dairy goats are in two separate shows and shall not compete against one another, nor may a goat be shown in both shows.
4. No exhibitor may enter more than one doe per class. Only 1 entry in Junior Doe and 1 entry in Senior Doe. Does of similar ages, whether registered or grade, will be shown in the same class. Exhibitor must show his or her own animal as listed on your entry form.
5. **The exhibitor or club/chapter must own the goat. No leased animals will be allowed.**
6. ALL animals must be born before October 1, 2025 in order to be entered and shown.
7. Scrapie tag is required for animal identification. See Animal Inspection Rules 5C-4.055 goats or sheep. ALL ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON SHOW DAY. Veterinarians will be available at check-in, however a charge of \$5.00 cash only will be required. If you do not have cash – you will be asked to leave the line and get cash and go to the back of the line.

### **SHEARING/CLIPPING**

8. All clipping done on fairgrounds must be done outside of the livestock barn. No shearing or clipping will be allowed inside stalls or barn aisles. Areas under the West stands and behind the barn will be used for this.

### **SHOW DAY**

9. Dairy Does REQUIRE A COMPLETED ANIMAL RECORD BOOK TO BE TURNED IN by the deadline posted on the Calendar of Events (on seyfair.com website). See General Rule #43. DAIRY GOAT EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN ANIMAL BOOK, however multiple animals can be included in the same single Record Book.
10. Failure to have an animal under control will result in disqualification.
11. Body clips and trimmed hooves are required.
12. Exhibitor must wear the official dress of his/her organization. (see General Rules #24)
13. The dairy goat and exhibitor must be present at the final check-in table and weigh-in.
14. Exhibitor should know the age of the doe and her freshening date.

### **CLASSES**

15. The Show Coordinators reserve the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the overall show.
