# INTRODUCTION TO THE SEYF DOG TRAINING

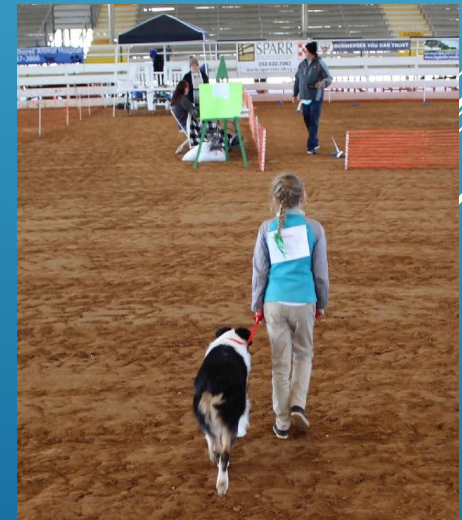
- Most of the information & training links in this presentation are from AKC (American Kennel Club) & Chewy.

# TYPES OF COLLARS REQUIRED AT TRAINING AND DOG SHOW

## OBEDIENCE & RALLY



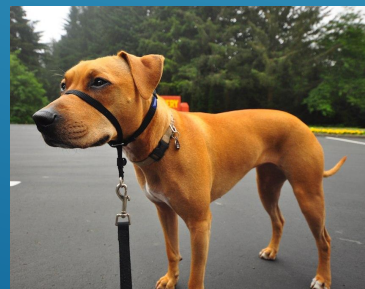
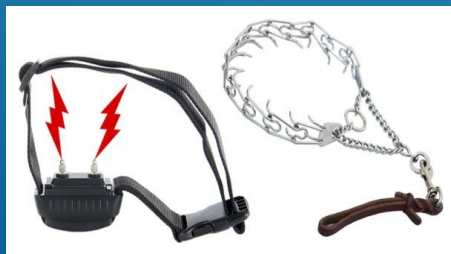
- A six (6) foot leash only!
- **No** retractable/flex leashes will be accepted.



- Choke-chain, nylon training collar, Flat buckle collar or martingale are required.



- **NO** pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted.



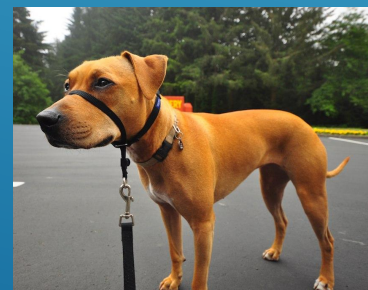
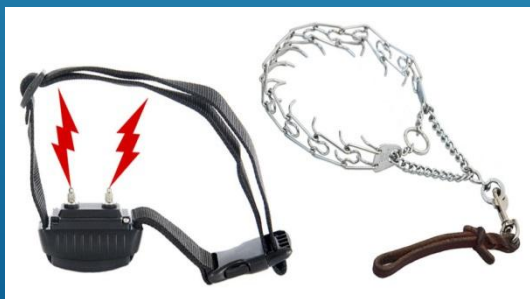
# TYPES OF COLLARS REQUIRED AT TRAINING AND DOG SHOW

## AGILITY

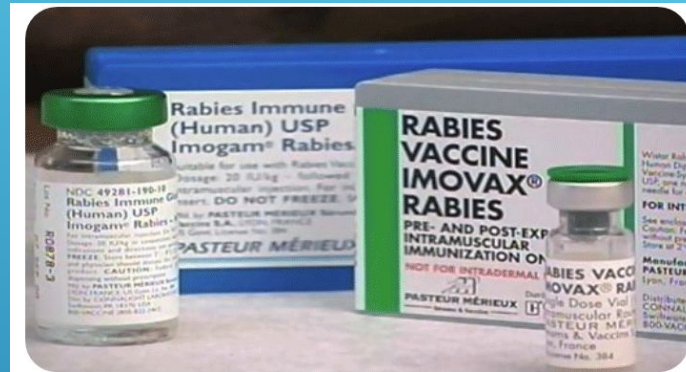
- If in on-leash classes, a six (6) foot leash only!
- **NO** retractable/flex leashes will be allowed.
- Buckle Collar only; **No tags or attachments are allowed.**



- **NO** pinch collars, lead collars, prong collars, harness or corrective collars of any kind are permitted.



# PROOF OF UP-TO-DATE VACCINATIONS REQUIRED PRIOR TO TRAINING AND DOG SHOW!



- ❑ **REQUIRED:** Upload a legible copy of your dog's vaccination records, signed off by your Veterinarian, with your fair entry or your entry will not be accepted.
- ❑ Recommended to bring a copy of your dog's records with you to training.
- ❑ Training will NOT be provided if you do not have a copy of up-to-date vaccination records.
- ❑ Required: Bring an updated copy of your dog's vaccinations with you to check in at the show.
