1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. Scrapie tag is required for animal identification. See Animal Inspection Rules 5C-4.055 goats or sheep. **ALL ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CURRENT VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE ON SHOW DAY. Veterinarians will be available at check-in, however a charge of \$5.00 cash only will be required. If you do not have cash – you will be asked to leave the line and get cash and go to the back of the line.**
3. No fresh cut horns. Wounds MUST be completely healed.
4. Meat Doe Goats, Market Wethers and Dairy Goats are in two separate shows and shall not compete against one another, nor may a goat be shown in both shows. Pygmy goats do not have a separate class. They will compete against meat classes and judged to meat standards.
5. No exhibitor may enter more than one animal per class. (i.e 1 for junior meat doe, 1 for senior meat doe). Exhibitor must show his or her own animal, unless leased.
6. **The objective of the leasing of a goat is to provide qualified, hard-working 4H and FFA youth who either lack the means and/or the facilities, with greater opportunity to gain hands-on learning experience with an animal to be shown at the 2025 Southeastern Youth Fair. Animals leased must conform to general rules and show rules. A complete Southeastern Youth Fair Lease Agreement with all signatures and dates must accompany the entry form by entry deadline. A goat must be shown by the same exhibitor each year unless the said goat was not shown the previous year. All lease agreements are subject to approval by the show coordinator.**
7. Horned Meat DOE goats are allowed provided that no goat is unruly or abusive.
8. Kids must be born before October 1, 2024 in order to be entered and shown.

SHOW DAY

9. See Calendar of Events for dates of when Record books are due to be turned in to the SEYF office.
10. BREEDING MEAT DOES REQUIRE A COMPLETED ANIMAL RECORD BOOK, however multiple animals can be included in the same single Record Book.
11. Failure to have an animal under control will result in disqualification.
12. Exhibitor must wear the official dress of his/her organization. (see General Rules #24)
13. Animal should be clean and have neatly trimmed hooves.

SHEARING

- **All clipping done on fairgrounds must be done outside of the livestock barn. No shearing or clipping will be allowed inside stalls or barn aisles. Areas under the West stands and behind the barn will be used for this.**

CLASSES

14. The Show Coordinators reserve the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the overall show.
- **Some classes will be divided into small groups according to entries. The top three (3) of these groups will be brought back to show for the Class placings.
