### **PURPOSE**

To assist a participant, or participants, of the Southeastern Youth Fair to attend the College, University or Technical school of their choice.

- The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this program.
- Applicants must be high school seniors in a Marion County 4-H and FFA program. They must have participated in the Southeastern Youth Fair for at least three (3) years and be involved in the current Youth Fair.
- Completed applications must be received in the Fair office by January 16, 2025.

### **JUDGING CRITERIA & SELECTION**

- The primary considerations are Application completeness, level of participation in the Southeastern Youth Fair, and College, University, or Technical school plans.
- Interviews will be held. Applicants will be notified of the date and time. Official 4-H or FFA dress is required.

### **AWARD**

- This scholarship is for help associated with post-secondary expenses during College, University, or Technical school of the recipient's choice.
- Documentation such as class schedules or receipt of book purchases must be submitted to the Fair office before funds are dispersed.
- Scholarship Award will be forfeited if proper paperwork and receipts are not submitted to the Fair office PRIOR to the second calendar year following the award.
- An original Thank you letter to your sponsor must be submitted to the SEYF office no later than the deadline stated in the SEYF general rules.
