- 1. The SEYF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
- 2. All exhibitors are encouraged to be enrolled in 4-H by November 14, 2025. Some exceptions may apply. Permission must be requested in writing to Show Coordinator.
- 3. All exhibitors must have a direct familial affiliation with another SEYF exhibitor, show committee volunteer, SEYF Board member, or Marion County 4H/FFA leader. Online entry will have a space to enter your "SEYF Connection."
- 4. All exhibitors must be 8 years old as of September 1, 2025.
- 5. Entries must be completed online (visit <a href="www.seyfair.com">www.seyfair.com</a>). See Calendar of Events for deadline date (November).
- 6. Do not bring any goats they will be supplied by the Fair.
- 7. This show will be scheduled in conjunction with the Meat, Dairy & Market Goat Shows. The show will begin immediately following the conclusion of these shows, prior to Kiddie Goat Show (approximately 4 pm).
- 8. As this is our first year, we will limit the capacity to 50 exhibitors. If the capacity is maxed out, please email the SEYF Director (<a href="mailto:seyfair@gmail.com">seyfair@gmail.com</a>) or Show Coordinator (<a href="mailto:mschensley@aol.com">mschensley@aol.com</a>) to request to be added to the waitlist.
- 9. Any special accommodation needed for the exhibitor MUST be included in the online entry. Failure to communicate needs could result in being excluded from the show. Safety is our priority!

## 10.SHOW DAY:

- a. A parent/guardian/authorized escort must remain with the exhibitor the entire time from check-in to check-out.
