
# **HOW TO MAKE YOUR ENTRIES ONLINE (NON-MARKET)**

**STEP ONE:** <u>www.seyfair.com</u> – click on either spot to begin entering Sept 2-16 for market animals & Nov 1-15 for everything else




STEP TWO: Select "Sign In"

Choose "I am a EXHIBITOR" if you are an exhibitor entering yourself.

Choose "I am a QUICK GROUP" if you're a parent entering multiple children.

Choose "I am a CLUB" if you are a club or chapter leader entering your club/chapter projects.



### **STEP THREE:**

Exhibitors - Enter First and Last Name if you chose "I am a EXHIBITOR"

Parents with multiple Exhibitors - Make your First Name "Family" and then enter your Last Name if you chose "I am a QUICK GROUP" Then you'll enter the name and info for the first child – when done with all entries for the first child, there will be a blue button near the bottom that says "Add Entries for a different Exhibitor" so you can begin entering info for the next child.

**Chapter/Club Leaders -** Make your First Name "<u>FFA-Chapter</u>" or "<u>4H-Club</u>" (use dash & no spaces). Make Last Name your <u>school or club Name</u> if you chose "I am a <u>CLUB</u>"

**EVERYONE** - If this is your first time entering this year, choose "I AM A NEW EXHIBITOR." If you've already made entries for the 2026 SEYF, then choose "I have previously registered this year."

## Remember if it has a BLUE STAR, it's REQUIRED

## REMEMBER YOUR PASSWORD!!! Write it down or take a photo of it!

You will need this all year to sign back in at any time!! Fill out all your personal information, then click:




STEP FOUR: Time to choose which show/contest you're making an entry for!

NOTICE any important information in the YELLOW BOX! Please READ IT!

\*\*If you show in both 4H and FFA, you MUST make sure you're choosing the correct one for EACH of your entry will be final!


**REMEMBER: BLUE STARS = REQUIRED** 



**STEP FIVE:** Click "Add Entry to Cart." Repeat the process if adding other entries until complete. When ready to finalize, click **CONTINUE**.

IF YOU ARE ENTERING FOR A WATCH ME GROW EXHIBITOR, ALL contests are at the bottom of the list – Scroll Down to WMG!

Please DO NOT enter "Animal Fever" or "Home Arts" or "BBQ Contest." All WMG entries begin with "WMG" in the Title.




STEP SIX: "Review Your Cart."

YOU'RE NOT DONE!! You must Click on CHECK OUT to finalize & submit your entries.

If you're a "Quick Group" and need to continue adding another exhibitor's entries, click the other blue button.

## **HORSE SHOW**


This show requires extra fees beyond the SEYF \$5 entry fee. Please select the correct amount that applies to your entry before checking out.



STEP SEVEN: Enter your credit card information to be charged/pay for your entry fees.

STEP EIGHT: Before you can complete, you will also need to type YES in the agreement box on the Screen, then click SUBMIT. BE SURE YOU SCROLL ALL THE WAY TO THE BOTTOM!

I knowingly and voluntarily execute this release with the express intention of extinguishing any obligations, claims, and causes of action as herein set forth. I knowingly and voluntarily, hereby release and forever discharge SOUTHEASTERN YOUTH FAIR, its individual volunteers, Board members, administrators, staff, assigns, executors, and corporations from any and all claims, obligations, demands, damages, actions, causes of action or suits of any kind or nature whatsoever, known and unknown, both to the person and property, which may result, or in the future develop, from my participation in the exhibitions and contests at the Southeastern Youth Fair. 

This does NOT guarantee your entry form is complete! Approval must be made by club leader and SEYF office before your entry is official. Some shows require a MANDATORY ONLINE TRAINING to be done by a certain deadline. Please see show rules to confirm if any other documents are required for your entries.

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

# How do I see my past entries when I log back in to Showorks?

First off, you have to make sure you're using the correct names and password that you used when you first made your entries, so make sure you remember how you entered!! REMEMBER if you chose "I am a Exhibitor/QuickGroup/Club" in STEP TWO.

And, if you followed STEP THREE exactly, then you should be golden! Once you sign in, you can go to the top right blue box that says "Hello", hover over the drop-down menu, then select "Your Past Transactions."



"Animal's Address" – what is this? Some exhibitors don't have their animals at the home address. Some are at the 4H farm, school campus, etc. Please enter the information of where the animal is housed.

## What does "Homegrown" mean?

An animal that was born and raised to an animal owned by the exhibitor, their parents, or grandparents. If the animal was already bred when purchased, the offspring is NOT homegrown. An embryo transfer is NOT homegrown. The Show Committee's determination as to eligibility shall be conclusive.

# OTHER UPDATES AND TIPS:

### **WATCH ME GROW PARTICIPANTS!**

Please make sure you choose the correct option for your child's entries! Scroll to the bottom – do NOT choose "Animal Fever" – please choose "WMG-Animal Fever."

## **BEEF HEIFER PARTICIPANTS**

**Is an EID number required?** YES it is required!! If you don't have it at the time you do your online entry – please be sure to email, text, or call the Show Coordinator (Stephanie Edwards).

If you are leasing your animals, you must email the signed SEYF Lease Agreement to <a href="mailto:seyfair@gmail.com">seyfair@gmail.com</a> BY deadline day - NOVEMBER 18, 2025.

#### LAMB SHOW PARTICIPANTS

MARKET LAMB EXHIBITORS WHOSE MARKET ANIMAL IS A EWE I have a EWE that I am entering in the MARKET SHOW... Do I need to make another entry in November if I want to show her in the Breeding Show as well? YES!!!

If I have a market lamb (wether) and also a breeding ewe, do I need to do a "Market Lamb" record book AND a "Breeding Lamb" record book also? **YES!** 

THERE IS NO LEASING OF ANY LAMBS OR GOATS THIS YEAR!

## LEASED HORSES - SEYF LEASE AGREEMENT IS REQUIRED!

If you are leasing your animals, you must email the signed SEYF Lease Agreement to <a href="mailto:seyfair@gmail.com">seyfair@gmail.com</a> BY deadline day NOVEMBER 18, 2025. ALSO – Horse show requires extra show fees – be sure you select the appropriate payment box before completing your entries!

#### **DOG SHOW**

Dog Show participants are required to submit veterinary records – please submit to <a href="mailto:seyfair@gmail.com">seyfair@gmail.com</a> BY deadline day - NOVEMBER 18, 2025. (If you have a set veterinary appointment for updated immunizations after 11/18, just submit your most recent records and then email new records after your new vet appointment).

#### **HORSE SHOW**

This show requires extra fees beyond the SEYF \$5 entry fee. Please select the correct amount that applies to your entry before checking out.

### **ANIMAL FEVER**

I know that ceramics are limited and it's first come-first served – how do I know if I get a ceramic?

The computer will not allow you to make an entry for Animal Fever when we are maxed out, so if you successfully make an entry and get a receipt, that means you have paid for your entry & ceramic too (the fees are combined) and you can come into the SEYF office at ANY time to pick up your ceramic!

AS SOON AS YOUR ENTRY IS COMPLETE, YOU MAY COME PICK UP YOUR CERAMIC!!

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

I have selected the Photography Contest – what else do I need to do besides my entry?

Your child can choose to submit **UP TO** three photo submissions (make sure to read this year's categories to know what to submit). Each photo must have a white photo matte purchased from the SEYF office. You can choose to make that purchase online OR in person. They are \$5 each. You will see the option to choose this online around Step 6 in Showorks (Exhibitor Fees).

## **HOME ARTS - KITCHEN - SEWING**

For these contests – you only have to complete ONE entry, but your child can submit multiple projects within the show's guidelines. See the RULES online for each show's categories and submission rules.

#### LIVESTOCK JUDGING

Entries for this contest aren't due November 18<sup>th</sup> – you have til January 23 to make these entires, but because it often confuses, I thought it'd be nice to try to explain it now. You can enter as an individual. If you'd like to be part of a team, you must also enter as an individual. Then your leader will enter a team entry. He/She can build her team only from the kids who are entered individually. Only leaders can enter "team" entries. Make sure you do an "individual" entry so that he/she can add you to the team!

## **PLANT ID CONTEST**

There will be a new way of judging "teams" this year. Everyone will be scored individually, and then the top 3-4 exhibitors' scores from a particular club/chapter will be grouped together to show the winners. So be sure your entry reflects which 4-H or FFA group you want your scores to reflect with!

So, if Apple 4-H club has six participants, then the top 3 scores make up first place ABC team, and the bottom 3 scores make up 2<sup>nd</sup> place ABC team.

So club/chapter leaders will NOT make team entries this year!

## **TABLESCAPING**

Another new one – see website for rules and details! **This is limited to the first 12 entries** and each entry is for a TEAM of 2 to 4 people (Jr, Int, and SR divisions)

So, if Winifred, Mary, and Sarah want to enter as a team, then just Wini will make the entry for her team. Then Wini would email <a href="mailto:seyfair@gmail.com">seyfair@gmail.com</a> to let us know Mary and Sarah's names and information to have on file as her team.
